BURNING When can you burn? Burning may only be carried out between October 1st and the last day of February, and between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Burning in piles or in strips may only be carried out after establishing a fire site clear of all vegetation and accessible to a fire engine, and after submitting a prior declaration to the town hall at least 72 hours in advance



BRUSH CLEARING : A REMINDEER OF SAFETY

RULES : Clearing brush around homes, roads, and other facilities or equipment is the best protection: 90% of homes destroyed in forest fires are located on land that has not been cleared, or has been poorly cleared.



As a reminder, the Smictom of the Périgord Noir is, like the other unions in the department, a founding member of the SMD3. The latter, of which the municipality is a member, had requested a 3-year moratorium, before deciding whether to integrate the SMD3 with certain conditions and the transition to the incentive fee. During its meeting of June 30, 2025 and after debate, the President proposes that the Smictom of the Périgord Noir commit to the direction of a single governance within an enlarged SMD3, from January 1, 2026. The conditions are specified in a draft agreement (the details of which can be consulted on the Smictom of the Périgord



Noir website). Votes cast for the transition to SMD3 as of January 1, 2026: 58 votes for, 3 votes against (including the municipality) and 11 abstentions. 2026 will be a "blank year" to get everyone used to badgering to open black containers. The household waste tax will remain due on the 2026 Property Tax. In 2027, we will move to the SMD3 incentive fee. A letter will be sent to each household by the Smictom du Périgord Noir. No action needs to be taken immediately.





Last May, the co-president of Castel en Fête, from the commune of Saint-Julien-le-Châtel, in the Creuse department, expressed a desire to establish a twinning relationship with our town.

This small village of 150 inhabitants is located in the northeast of the Creuse department, on the border with the Allier.

Rich in natural sites such as the yellowish stones and the Sédelle Valley of Painters, it is close to Lake Vassière, the Puy de Dôme volcano chain, the International Tapestry City, and the medieval town of Aubusson. Saint-Julien-le-Châtel is less than three hours from Peyzac-le-Moustier.



This twinning project would create a link between our two villages through our communes and associations, for a social, cultural, and human benefit, as well as a form of tourism through excursions to discover our sites. Your elected officials and the Friends of Moustier association are in favor of working on this twinning project. But, of course, it won't be possible if everyone joins us. That's why I suggest you contact the secretariat to express your interest in being part of this working group. For this adventure to be successful, it must be experienced together.

Cycle Route / Greenway



By resolution of 10/04/2025, the community council approved the Vézère cycle route between Les Eyzies and Coly-Saint Amand, with reservations about certain sectors. The initial option of Les Eyzies-Tursac via the 7 Frères has been abandoned in favor of a new route envisaged by La Madeleine (less expensive, existing paths, lower environmental impact). Regarding the route in the commune of Peyzac-le-Moustier, the new-

ly envisaged route has little impact on the initial route. For the entire Les Eyzies-Coly-Saint-Amand route, new studies are underway for certain sectors that had raised issues. This additional study being undertaken, the deadline for the final submission of the project is extended by 6 months. As a reminder, the municipality has included €38,000.00 in the 2025 budget for the acquisition of land, which is divided: €19,000.00 to be paid by the municipality / €19,000.00 CC-VH/State subsidies. This program will be included in the 2026 Budget.
